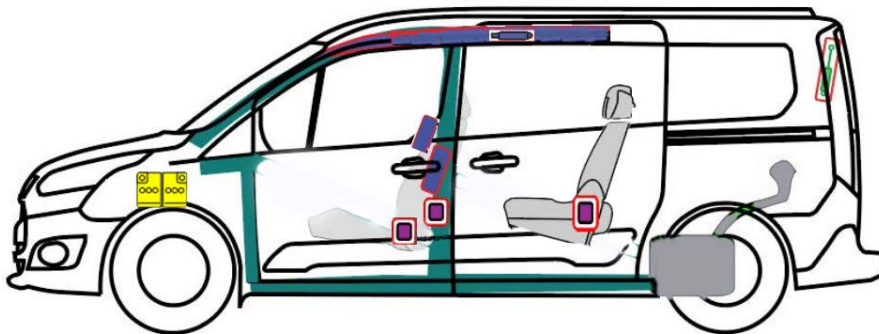
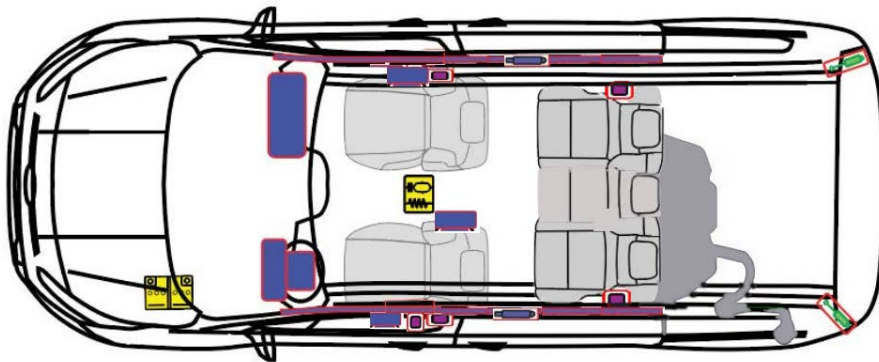

Label on the front grill and the rear tailgate.

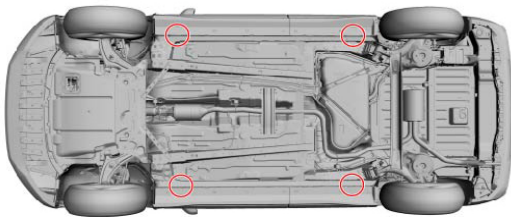
## 2. Immobilisation / stabilisation / lifting

Press the "START-STOP" button on the steering rack.



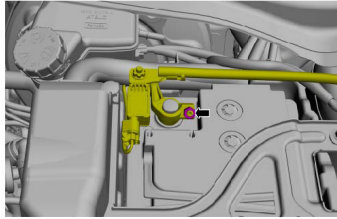
